Radstock Fayre is happening on **Sunday 31st May**  
at **St. Nicholas Church Field**, Radstock, BA3 3QQ

# GENERAL INFORMATION

St. Nicholas Church Field is a grassy area with some uneven ground.

The Theatre Stage is on hard standing (to the left of the photo).

Stalls and the Community Stage will be set up on the edges of the field, on grass.



People who use manual wheelchairs may need additional help to manage the grassy area.



There is an **Information Tent** by the site entrance, with a sign outside. Mark, Netty or Ashley will be there and can support you with information or help. They will be wearing **blue vests**.



The field can be noisy. We have a **Quiet Space** in a bell tent for people who want some peace and quiet. Please ask for the location at the Information Tent.

# THEATRE, DANCE & CIRCUS



Some Theatre shows will happen at the **Theatre Stage** - located at the top of the field, on hard standing. The area will be marked with a sign. Other performances will happen across the site.

**Seating** is available on hay bales.

There is no designated Disabled Viewing Area. Please ask our event staff for help to assure a good spot.

There will be performances all afternoon.

Timings will be available in the Information Tent. **Timings may change** and will updated here in the event of bad weather or other unexpected events

Radstock Fayre is run by the **Natural Theatre Company**, who are experts in walkabout theatre. Performers walk through a crowd interacting with people rather than staying on a traditional stage. You can interact with them if you want but you don't have to.

Actors from the Naturals will be performing alongside local young people from community groups.

# STAND AND DELIVER!

**Stand and Deliver!** is a family friendly outdoor theatre show by Cat & Mouse Theatre. There is a visually impaired performer in Stand and Deliver!

Stand and Deliver is about the gulf between rich and poor and hopes for a fairer world. It uses clowning, theatre and involves lots of potatoes!



The performers will invite you to join in as characters in the story. You do not have to join in if you don't want to.

**SHOW TIMES: 12 PM and 2 PM**

**DURATION : 30 MINUTES**



The show has been created with integrated **Audio Description**.



A free **10 minute Touch Tour** is available to experience the costumes and props through touch before the 12PM show of Stand and Deliver!

Anyone under 18 attending must be accompanied by an adult.

## **Sensitive subject and Loud Noises:**

- The show is about justice and the idea of hanging is discussed.
- At the beginning a judge is pulled on a cart while ringing a bell. Edmund is in chains with a bag on his head.
- The judge bangs a hammer and shouts quite often.
- Half way through there is a robbery scene with shouting. A character carries a gun but it never goes off.
- There is loud music played at the end of the show.

# TRUTH!

**TRUTH!** is an outdoor theatre show by Ramshacklicious & Hijinx. It is suitable for all ages. There are 5 disabled and non-disabled performers in TRUTH!

TRUTH is about how we can have less conflict and more joy in our lives. It uses clowning, theatre and dance.

The performers will invite you to join in with actions and sounds. You do not have to join in if you don't want to.

A free **10 minute Touch Tour** is available to experience the costumes and props through touch before the 1pm performance of TRUTH! Anyone under 18 attending must be accompanied by an adult.

## **Loud Noises and Theatrical Effects:**

- In the middle of TRUTH! there is a scene with loud voices and a loud horn played by a performer. This lasts about a minute and includes a non-toxic smoke effect, mounted on a long pole (above head height).
- A confetti cannon is used at the end of the scene. It fills the sky and the performance space with biodegradable confetti.

**Tasty Food and Drinks** are available at the **Swallows Cafe** at the entrance to the site and you will find **Nomad's Barbecue** and **The Ice-cream Lady** around the edge of the field.

If you suffer from allergies you may wish to come with snacks.

Accessible Toilets are available on the site:

- Inside St Nicholas Church Rooms, Radstock, BA3 3QQ
- Accessible portaloo outside the Swallow Cafe by the Blue Badge parking

A Changing Places toilet is located at Tom Huyton Park, Somervale Road, Radstock, BA3 3BA from 9am - 6pm

This is a 1 minute drive or a 10 minute walk from the event site.

It opens with a Radar Key.

The Fayre is at St. Nicholas Church Field, next to Swallow Cafe, Radstock, BA3 3QQ

Four Blue Badge car parking spaces are available in the carpark at St Nicholas Church Rooms / Swallow Cafe.

There will be a person on the gate who can advise you.

Additional cars, minibuses and coaches will have to drop off passengers and park elsewhere. We will manage a drop off spot for people using wheelchairs or mobility vehicles.

Blue Badge holders can park for free on roads in Radstock, although the town can be congested. The largest carpark is Church St, Radstock BA3 3QG - Blue Badge holders can park anywhere. This is a 5 minute walk to the event site.
